
## Be in to win a computer tablet in the "Name the Drone" competition for school students!



Land Information New Zealand has begun using a drone or UAV (unmanned aerial vehicle) to help with the management of wilding pines. The use of the drone will be demonstrated during the High Country hi-tech Virtual Field Trip for schools from 12-14 May 2015 in the Mackenzie Country.

Students from classes that are enrolled for the Virtual Field Trip are eligible to suggest a name for the drone as pictured. The student whose name suggestion is chosen by the judges will win a computer tablet and in addition the school class will win a GoPro camera!

To enter the competition, each class teacher will need to:

- 2. Send an email to <a href="mailto:namethedrone@linz.govt.nz">namethedrone@linz.govt.nz</a> by Tuesday 5 May and include:
  - School name
  - Class name
  - Teacher name and email address

For each student entering a name for the drone:

- Student name and age
- Suggested name for the drone
- One or two brief sentences on why that name was chosen.

The winning name, student, and class teacher will be advised during the High Country hi-tech Virtual Field Trip and subsequently on the Land Information New Zealand website – <a href="www.linz.govt.nz">www.linz.govt.nz</a>. The decision of the judges will be final. If the judges choose a name that has been suggested by more than one student, the winning student will be drawn by ballot from among those students.
